The Armed Forces Financial Network Reaches \$1 Million Milestone in Military Family Support Program

ST. PETERSBURG, Fla., Feb. 14, 2011 – The [Armed Forces Financial Network](#) (AFFN) today announced that more than \$1 million has been raised and distributed via their Community Support Program. The three-part program includes the AFFN Corporate Giving Program, The AFFN Matching Grant Program and the AFFN Thank You Card Program.

Over the past seven years, the AFFN Community Support Program has continued to grow its outreach programs for assisting servicemen and servicewomen and their families. The programs have distributed a combined total of \$1 million. Through the AFFN Matching Grant Program, AFFN and participating local financial institutions have awarded grants to 224 programs that directly benefit U.S. service members and their families. The AFFN Corporate Giving Program has contributed to such programs as the Fisher House Foundation, Pentagon Federal Credit Union Foundation and the Warrior and Family Support Center at Fort Sam Houston, Texas.

Designed to be distributed to military service members and their families throughout the world, the AFFN Thank You Card Program provides prepaid cards as a token of thanks for service to their country. The cards are presented to family members of wounded service members while the family members are staying at one of 53 Fisher Houses located on 18 military installations and 15 Veterans Affairs (VA) medical centers worldwide. Fisher Houses provide housing for military families while a loved one is being treated in the hospital for an illness, disease or injury. The cards can be used at more than 500,000 ATMs and over 2 million point-of-sale locations throughout the world where U.S. armed forces personnel are stationed.

The AFFN Thank You Card Program was initiated in 2003 and is managed through AFFN with the assistance of FIS. FIS produced a custom-designed card and processed these prepaid debit cards free of charge in recognition of the service and sacrifice of military members and their families. The funding of the cards comes from both AFFN and FIS corporate sponsorships as well as revenue derived from card processing, which FIS distributes back into the program.

“We are thrilled to have reached this \$1 million milestone,” said Dave Weber, president, AFFN. “This is a wonderful program that recognizes the amazing sacrifice of not only the service members, but their family members as well. We are thankful for the contributions of all our partners and the participating financial institutions that help make this program possible.”
